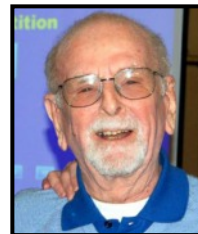

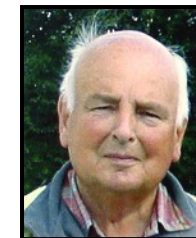

Keith has won many awards in AV Competitions; most notably first places at The Adelaide AV Festival with "The Bench" and The Peter Coles International with "The Quiet One"

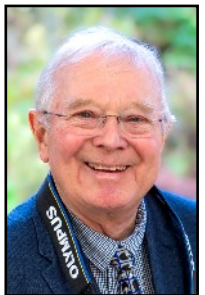
He has enjoyed the many opportunities AV has given him: lecturing & judging both at home and abroad and along with his late wife, Kate, showing their AVs.
